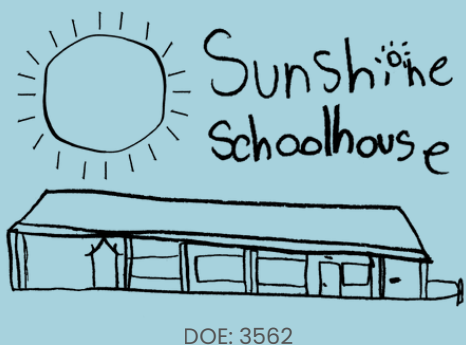




Kindergarten Through Sixth Grade

What to Know About our Creatori Classes

Our K-6 school day runs from 9:00–3:00 Mon–Fri. We don't follow the calendar of the local school district, so be sure to check our calendar for our days off.

We do provide wraparound care if needed between 7am–6pm. See the following pages for more information if you're interested.

We serve grades K-6. If your child is behind or ahead of grade level, we will work with them where they are!

Students bring in their own lunch and have 45–60 minutes of recess each day for physical and social development.

Private School vs. Homeschool Enrichment

The only difference in our two programs is the schedule. Private school is Mon–Fri 9:00–3:00 and homeschool enrichment is *either* Mon/Wed/Fri from 9:00–3:00 *or* Tues/Thurs from 9:00–3:00. The curriculum is the same and homeschool and private school students are mixed in the same classes together.

The difference on your end is whether you register with the county as a homeschool student or enroll here as a private school student.

K-5 ENRICHMENT CLASSES



Our daily enrichment classes are held in addition to language arts and math. These multi-disciplinary classes teach exciting lessons, activities, and long-term projects that encourage a love of learning.

Superhero Academy Students train like heroes as they build confidence, empathy, teamwork, and problem-solving skills.

Yoga Through movement, breath, and mindfulness, students strengthen their bodies, calm their minds, and learn tools for focus and emotional regulation in a fun, age-appropriate way.

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Art Off the Canvas This hands-on art class goes beyond drawing and painting as students explore sculpture, collage, fiber arts, mixed media, and more.

Weird and Wonderful Places From glowing caves to floating islands and hidden cities, students explore Earth's strangest and most fascinating locations while learning geography, science, and cultural history.

Fashion Through Time Students travel through history while learning design basics, hand-sewing skills, and how clothing reflects culture and function across time.

Natural Disasters Students investigate earthquakes, volcanoes, hurricanes, and more, learning the science behind extreme events, how they impact people, and how engineers and communities respond.

Private School Annual Tuition

\$8,000/year

Tuition can be paid weekly, monthly, or through a Step Up For Students scholarship.

Tuition paid monthly or weekly is split equally throughout the school year for the convenience of the parents. Tuition payments will be the same each week/month regardless of the number of days school is in session that particular week or month.

Homeschool enrichment classes are held from 9:00–3:00 on:

or Tuesdays/Thursdays **\$120/wk**

Fees

Annual registration fee of \$150.

Camp & Wrap Care

We offer camps and wrap around care for families needing care before and/or after school or during school breaks. Wrap around care is from 7:00–9:00am and 3:00–6:00pm for **\$60/wk.**

Camps are open 7:00am–6:00pm for **\$60/day** or **\$180/wk.**
